Information Pathways for the Krewe

As we always try to keep Krewe members apprised of anything going on we have a number of ways we do this. There are three primary means of communication with the Krewe.

MEMBER MEETINGS

We have monthly scheduled meetings. During the summer months they may be activities rather than information meetings, but during the rest of the year we usually have important information regarding events, costuming, throws, and general Krewe business. Meetings will usually include a PowerPoint presentation and may have printed handouts. We do not distribute minutes for the meetings. It is important to attend meetings as we do cover a lot of information that would answer a lot of questions a member might have.

Some meetings we have may be posted on our public Facebook page and those are meetings that are open to the public for member recruitment purposes. However, when we discuss parades, logistics, or Krewe business those meetings are generally not open to the public.

have a public Facebook page "Krewe of Krampus" for that. Some meetings we have may be posted to that page and those are meetings that are open to the public for member recruitment purposes.



There is a "Members Only" login section on our Krewe website. To login click on the emoji (face with the tongue sticking out) in the upper right hand corner or click on the "Members Only" text link in the bottom left of the footer, which will bring you to the above page. If you have never visited this page just click on the "Register as New Member" tab and follow the instructions. Once you receive the login information just enter it on the login screen (see above), click on the "Krewe Dashboard" tab, and you will see the following page:



The "Members Dashboard" will usually have a highlight of the next event and this is the area that will give you access to the calendar, costuming resources, downloads, membership terms, code of conduct, and your account.

Calendar - Any regularly scheduled monthly meetings are posted in the "Calendar" section every January for that year. We will periodically update this calendar to reflect additional meetings as we get close to a parade or update events as new opportunities arise, but you will also see this information on the private Facebook group for members only.

Costuming resources – this is a list of resources that have been compiled to assist members in creating or adding to their costumes. It includes links to costumes/pre-made, contacts, wigs, fabric and faux fur, patterns, and sparkly bits. It also includes links at the bottom to red alpine hat resources.

Downloads – this section has a coal guideline document (you received a printed version of this with your coal) for decorating and coal packaging tags for the Krewe and Sisters of Shhh. We tried to make it easy with providing tags, but feel free to create your own with the information provided.

Membership terms – these are the terms governing membership.

Code of Conduct – ALL members are required to read and be familiar with our Code of Conduct. We expect all members to adhere to it.
